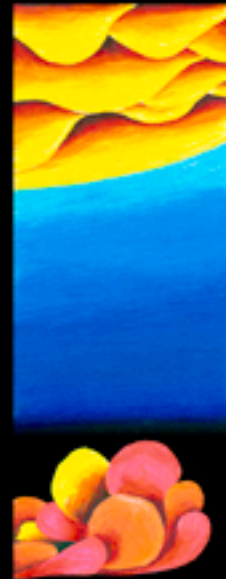
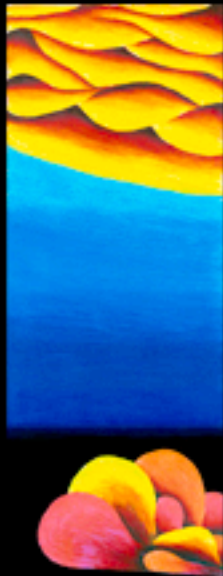


Selective Color

on the cover: **Hands of Joy**

This is part of a set that is designed to hang on a wall over 20 feet tall.

left: **Shadows**

Here I use light and color to flow through the entire piece. It is my first significant use of the paper's whiteness as a color. Completed in the middle of 2006 in San Jose, California, this is the most recent of all the pieces in this book.



Tree of Life

The light rippling through this piece gives it more shades of green and more combinations of yellow and red than any other piece. It is the third most recent of all these pieces. You can see a progression towards using light differently in the more recent pieces.

following page: **Small Smoke**

Small Smoke is the second piece I did. I drew it while living in New York in 1999 - 2000. The insignificant smoke of human origin contrasts with the volcano's smoke. Along the way, I throw in a healthy mixture of colors and neutrals.

In this drawing I chart my own artistic direction. I have never taken drawing lessons, nor do I base my work on that of another single artist. In terms of context, the most that can be said of my work is that it looks Hispanic. I am not ethnically Hispanic, but I did grow up in Mexico.
